## Denmark among the favourites to land the European Medicines Agency

As a consequence of Brexit, the European Medicines Agency (EMA), which for now is based in the UK, needs a new residence, and Denmark seems to be an early favourite in the race. Danish politicians, interest organisations, scientists and several companies are all backing the candidacy. Kromann Reumert also sees a great potential in Denmark being the home of the EMA.

Denmark and the city of Copenhagen is believed to be among the frontrunners along with Sweden, Spain and Ireland. In total twenty nations have officially shown interest in securing the EMA.

In a recent push to win the EMA, the Danish Prime Minister Lars Løkke Rasmussen, Foreign Minister Anders Samuelsen, Mayor of Copenhagen Frank Jensen and former CEO of Novo Nordisk Lars Rebien Sørensen have all been lobbying the EU, and the Danish government has already rented the Copenhagen Towers in Ørestad to house the EMA.

The EMA is a very attractive agency to win. With it comes more than 900 employees, 36,000 yearly visitors and an economic lift worth an estimated €1
